

Severance and Scope of Case 002/02

Co-Accused Nuon Chea and Khieu Samphan

The Trial Chamber must balance requirements that the trial be fair and **expeditious** as well as remain reasonably **representative** of of Closing Order (Supreme Court Chamber, Decision E284/4/8)

25 November 2013: Supreme Court Chamber indicates that the minimum charges and crime sites to be included in Case 002/02 are S-21, a worksite, a cooperative and genocide Decision E284/4/8

Chamber Releases Workplan for Case 002/02. Decision 301/5

31 January 2014: Parties submit Case 002/02 Scope Submissions. Parties vary in their views on additional severance of Case 002/02

4 April 2014: Trial **Chamber Decision** on Additional Severance of Case 002/02 and Scope of Case 002/02 Decision E301/9/1

24 December 2013: Trial

In its 4 April 2014 Decision, the Trial Chamber...

"GRANTS the Co-Prosecutors' and Lead Co-Lawvers' requests and SEVERS the proceedings in this case pursuant to

Internal Rule 89ter"

Rule 89ter allows the Trial iustice." to separate the proceedings to concern only **Internal Rules**

"GRANTS the Co-Prosecutors' and Lead Co-Lawyers' requests in part and DECIDES, pursuant to the Supreme Court Chamber order of 25 November 2013, that the scope of Case 002/02 crime base shall comprise the portions of the Closing Order pertaining to:

- S-21 Security Centre
- 1st January Dam Worksite,
- Tram Kok Cooperative,
- genocide (Vietnamese and Cham peoples)"

"GRANTS the Co-Prosecutors', Lead Co-Lawvers', and NUON Chea Defence requests in part and DECIDES to include within the scope of Case 002/02 crime base:

- Kraing Ta Chan Security Centre. Kampong Chhnang Airport Construction site.
 - · Au Kanseng Security Centre,
 - Phnom Kraol Security Centre,
 - Trapeang Thma Dam Worksite
 - the charges of Forced Marriage and Rape (nationwide)
 - Internal Purges"

REJECTS the Lead Co-Lawyers' requests to include within the scope of Case 002/02 North Zone Security Centre, the Koh Kyang Security Centre, and forced movement of population phase three and to expand the charges related to the treatment of Buddhists to a nationwide geographic scope.

REJECTS the NUON Chea Defence requests to include within the scope of Case 002/02 forced movement of population phase three and Wat Kirirum or Wat Tlork Security Centre

Findings of the **Trial Chamber in**

- Chamber finds "that the rights of the Accused would not be negatively impacted by lack of forseeability or any other concerns in the event of severance" (13)
- Chamber finds "any risk of inconsistencies between separate phases [of trial] will be minimal and do not constitute an impediment to severance" (15)
- Chamber finds "that it is possible to deal with the crimes outlined above within a reasonable time" (18)
- Chamber finds that the resulting evidentiary record from Case 002/01 will serve as the foundation for the remaining charges in Case 002. Many charges of the Closing Order not covered in Case 002/01 will be "expressly included within the scope of Case 002/02 insofar as they contain factual allegations previously or fully examined" (19)
